## CAPTIONED TELEPHONE

*We administer the analog Captioned Telephone (CapTel) program* which provides access to residential telephone services for Delawareans who have the ability to speak for themselves and also have difficulty hearing on the phone. Visit our website for more details.

## VISOR CARD

Only available through our office, a *Visor Card* is an official document approved through the Delaware Police Chief's Council. Used for emergencies, the card indicates to police and other emergency personnel that the driver is Deaf or Hard of Hearing.
